**Appointment of Advocate Panel**

The Maharashtra State Board of Waqfs, Aurangabad is willing to make a panel of advocates for pleading on behalf of Maharashtra State Board of Waqfs, Aurangabad in waqf matters before Bombay, Aurangabad and Nagpur benches of the Honourable High Court of judicature at Bombay, the Maharashtra State Waqf Tribunal, Aurangabad and quasi judicial proceedings related to waqf matters before various revenue authorities at district levels. The advocates to be impanelled should possess adequate knowledge (read, write and speak) of Urdu, Marathi and English languages and so also possess knowledge of Muslim Laws, more particularly of the Waqf Act, 1995 and jurisprudence. Preference will be given to advocates having three or more years of experience of legal practicing in courts of law.

In aforesaid circumstances, applications are invited from advocates who are willing to get empanelled as mentioned above. The willing advocates may submit their applications to this office alongwith the details of their qualifications, work experience and relevant date on or before 30.08.2021. Incomplete applications will not be considered. After primary scrutiny of applications, the advocates whose applications will be found complete will be called for interviews. Thereafter selected advocates will be informed accordingly and orders of empanelment will be issued. The decision of the Board taken in this regard will be final and no objections and representations made in this regard will be considered.


The Maharashtra State Board of Waqfs, Aurangabad reserves its rights to cancel any or all the applications made so without giving any reason.

Terms and conditions: -

1. The advocates impanelled should remain present for every hearing of the matter allotted to them in the court/ tribunal/ quasi judicial authority assigned to them. In case, for some unavoidable reasons, the

advocates are unable to attend their hearings, they should in advance inform the concerned court in writing about their absence.

2. Before 5<sup>th</sup> of every month, the impanelled advocates should submit a self appraisal in the formate attached herewith for previous month, his self appraisal shall contain numbers' of cases they had appeared, the documents, like say/ WS, filed (copies to be attached) and details of orders made by the concerning court and in whose favour those decisions have passed. The payments to the advocates for that particular month will not be made until such fully filled in self appraisal forms are submitted.
3. No any compromise/ withdrawal of the matter should be made without prior written permission of the Chief Executive Officer, Maharashtra State Board of Waqfs, Aurangabad.
